

In addition, a training course on the newest modality for diagnosis and staging of the thorax, endobronchial ultrasound guided TBNA(EBUS-TBNA), will be held in the afternoon of the second day. The workshop will not only present the latest instruments and their place in the diagnostic armamentarium, but participants will also have a chance to actually experience the EBUS-TBNA procedure in a hands-on seminar. The most experienced doctors will share their "tips and tricks" during the course.

We are pleased to announce that the 1st APCB will be held with speakers and participants from 22 countries around the world, who will present advances in bronchology and interventional pulmonology.

We look forward to stimulating discussions and informative presentations.






